Public Summary

AgriAs deliverable 7.3 Gender action report summarizes the representation of men and women in Project Management and their participation in project activities. One of the aims of AgriAs was to maintain a gender balance between the experts who will be invited to speak and/or participate in workshops, training sessions, seminars.

Of the seven work packages, four are being led by female professionals and three by male professionals. In addition to the WP leaders, the Governing Board (GB) of AgriAs includes five female professionals, who are also Principal Investigators of the project. The gender balance is thus maintained in both among the WP leaders and the Governing Board. Furthermore 33% of the Advisory Board members are women.
